I / we understand that the ASTA Race Committee may not permit my vessel to take part if they, in their absolute discretion, consider my vessel or its crew not fit to take part for any reason whatsoever and that the Race Committee shall not be obliged to give any reason for such decision. I also understand that an inspection of the vessel and/or its equipment by an official of ASTA is no indication that ASTA has in any way agreed that the vessel and/or its equipment are seaworthy, which are matters entirely under the control of the master.
 3. I / we agree to be bound by the 2008 version of the STI Sailing & Racing Rules (as modified by the Sailing Instructions) and by the Sailing Instructions and agree that in any dispute or matter relating to the racing, the decision of the ASTA Race Committee shall be final.
 4. I / we declare that it shall be our decision as to whether to start or continue in a race or cruise.

1. Rating Information: Representatives of vessels not already rated should fill out the measurement form carefully and return it to ASTA no later than March 1, 2009
2. Ages: No less than half of those on board vessels in the **youth sail training division** must be between the ages of 15 and 25 at the start of each race. Vessels in the **cruising division** are those unable to meet the minimum 50% youth requirement. For both divisions, *no one may be under 15 years of age during a race unless authorized.*

⇒ **Please enclose entry fee:** US and Canadian vessels may make checks payable to “ASTA”. For Canadian cheques, add US\$5 to the appropriate entry fee and then compute the exchange. Vessels from outside the U.S. and Canada may pay by credit card (preferred) or pay upon arrival in first port.
